Subject: Traffic signs

For years Dennison Street has been known to be a cut through street. Commuters travel East and West on Dennison Street to get to either M-24 or W. Burdick Street. Residents have complained of speeders due to the traffic volume. The Oxford Police Department attempts to enforce this issue on a daily basis but can't be there all hours of the day. It is the recommendation of this Department to add a stop sign at Dennison and Jersey for East and West bound traffic to attempt to slow traffic between Pontiac and West.

Dennison Street East of Pontiac Street needs a no parking here to corner for W/B traffic and a no parking this side of sign for E/B traffic East of Pontiac Street. Cars have been parking to close to the intersection and making it dangerous for cars to go around into oncoming traffic to turn onto Dennison Street or approach Pontiac Street.

The 2 stop signs will cost \$100 a piece. The 2 parking signs will cost \$80 a piece. Total \$360.00.
