RESIDENTIAL FENCE GUIDELINES

- A. Applicant must fill out a Fence Permit and submit plot plan of proposed fence to the Oxford Building Department.

- B. Fences, walls, or privacy screens in the R-1 district shall conform to the following:
 - 1) Shall NOT exceed six (6) feet in height above grade.
 - 2) Fences or walls within a front yard shall not exceed thirty (30) inches in height.
 - 3) Fences which are part of a deck structure shall not exceed four (4) feet in height above the surface of the deck.

- C. Fences, walls, or privacy screens shall not contain barbed wire, electric current or charge of electricity.

- D. Fences, walls, or privacy screens shall be maintained in good condition, so as not to endanger life or property.

NOTE: This handout is merely a guide. The Oxford Ordinance text regarding Fences can be found in Section 6.1.13.

In the event of a conflict between this handout and the Ordinance, the Ordinance text shall apply.
